¹ This application shall be subject to all additions to and changes in the laws, regulations and ordinances applicable to the proposed development until a determination of completeness has been made pursuant to LMC Chapter 21.07.

² "Display fireworks" means large fireworks designed primarily to produce visible or audible effects by combustion, deflagration, or detonation and includes, but is not limited to, salutes containing more than 2 grains (130 mg) of explosive materials, aerial shells containing more than 40 grams of pyrotechnic compositions, and other display pieces which exceed the limits of explosive materials for classification as "consumer fireworks" and are classified as fireworks UN0333, UN0334, or UN0335 by the United States department of transportation at 49 C.F.R. Sec. 172.101 as of June 13, 2002, and including fused setpieces containing components which exceed 50 mg of salute powder.

REQUIREMENTS

All required information and fees must be submitted at time of application. Applications which do not include all of the required information and fees may be returned to the applicant.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Fireworks Permits are subject to the requirements of Leavenworth Municipal Code (LMC) Chapter 8.36. The Code can be viewed online at www.cityofleavenworth.com. All drawing(s) must be on paper capable of being folded for storage in an 8 1/2" x 14" file, and become the property of the City of Leavenworth.
- Unless permitted, and except where exempt, it is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation within the city of Leavenworth to manufacture, import, possess or sell fireworks at wholesale or retail for any use, to discharge fireworks at any place, to make a public display of fireworks or to transport fireworks by means other than common carrier in compliance with Leavenworth Municipal Code 8.36.
- The applicant shall have a valid State of Washington Fireworks Public Display Permit from the Washington State Patrol authorizing the holder to conduct the proposed activity.
- A permit shall be used only by the designated permittee and shall not be assigned or otherwise transferred. Any transfer or purported transfer of a permit shall be deemed a violation of Leavenworth Municipal Code Chapter 8.36 and shall void the permit.
- Complete permit applications must be submitted to the City, and fees paid, by no later than 14 calendar days prior to the intended display.
- In addition to the other requirements of the Washington State Fireworks Law (RCW 70.77 and WAC 212-17), the applicant shall procure and maintain a policy or policies of public general liability, bodily injury and property damage insurance from a company or companies approved by the Leavenworth Fire Marshal in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00, single limit. The City of Leavenworth and Chelan County Fire District No. 3, and any other fire protection district providing fire protection certificates of coverage, shall be named as additional insured on such policy and shall be filed with the City of Leavenworth.

⁴ Such deposit shall be supplied to the City via personal, business, or cashier's check and is refundable upon confirmation of removal of temporary structures, launch pads, etc, cleaning of all debris from the site, and restoring the site to pre-display conditions. If the applicant removes all signs of the display, including all debris, and restores the site within two days after the end of the permitted fireworks activities, the applicant shall be entitled to the return of the deposit. If not removed, cleaned, and restored prior to that time, the \$500.00 deposit shall be forfeited and placed in the City of Leavenworth general fund and abatement proceedings will begin.

- The following provisions shall apply to the public display of fireworks:
 - All minimum clearances, site dimensions, separation clearances and landing areas shall be subject to review by and approval of the fire official. In the sole discretion of the fire official, the minimum standards of the State Fireworks Law may be increased to protect the public and property.
 - The applicant shall provide fire protection for the display. The fire official shall determine the level of personnel and equipment necessary. Prior to the public display, the applicant shall pay the full cost of the required personnel and equipment to Chelan County Fire District No. 3.
 - The applicant shall provide crowd control for the display. The fire official shall determine the level of crowd control necessary, including the number and placement of crowd control monitors. If local law enforcement is providing crowd control, the applicant shall pay the full cost of the required personnel and equipment to the appropriate law enforcement agency prior to the display.
 - If, in the opinion of the fire official, the sheriff or law enforcement agency, or the pyrotechnic operator, a lack of fire protection or crowd control poses a danger to the public or property, then the fire official, the sheriff or law enforcement agency, or the pyrotechnic operator shall immediately suspend the display until the danger is corrected.
 - Compliance with the State Fireworks Law, including all licensing and provisions as found therein, are applicable and in addition to City requirements.
