# MEETING NOTES

## I. CALL TO ORDER

## III. INFORMATION ITEMS

TD&H Engineer Mr. Steve Marsh began with a power point presentation and stated that he is the lead engineer on the Pine Street Reconstruction project and briefly addressed the recent survey completed by Chelan County and said that there are issues related to property lines, wetlands, and the construction of a new school. He went on to address the different types of street construction, taking into consideration the use of sidewalks, street parking, snow storage, and pedestrian traffic.

Mayor Farivar and Steve Marsh then answered questions and discussed concerns with the public regarding the following items:

- Street parking
- Sidewalks on one or both sides of the street
- Snow storage
- Safety for pedestrian use as well as a safe route to school
- Fast traffic and how to slow down vehicles
- Reconstruction taking place in phases

City Administrator Joel Walinski stated that this is the first of several meetings with the public in regard to the reconstruction of Pine Street. He explained that the project will take some time to begin as the City is still in the very early planning stages and will need to be further along with

the engineering process in order to apply for grant funding. He said that he anticipates the next meeting with the public will take place later in the summer in order to provide updated progress concerning the project.
