## CITY OF LEAVENWORTH NOTICE TO CONSULTANTS FOR CHUMSTICK HWY. MULTIPURPOSE TRAIL AND WATER/SEWER LINE EXTENSION

The City of Leavenworth is soliciting interest from consulting firms with expertise in Civil and Structural Engineering Design and Construction. This agreement will be for approximately 24 months in duration with the option for the City to extend it for additional time and money if necessary. Consultants will be considered for the following project:

### **Chumstick Hwy. Multipurpose Trail and Water/Sewer Line Extension**

The City of Leavenworth reserves the right to amend the term of this “Request for Qualifications” (RFQ) to circulate various addenda, or to withdraw the RFQ at any time, regardless of how much time and effort consultants have spent in their response.

### **Project Description**

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT is the construction engineering and project administration for improvements related to the construction of the Chumstick Multi Use Trail and the extension of the water and sewer transmission lines. Bid documents, plan sets and contract provisions have been completed for this project. The major features of the project construction include the following:

- Installation and construction of 2,100 feet of pedestrian and bicycle trail which is 20 feet wide and BST surfacing;
- Installation and construction of 670 linear feet of 12 inch ductile iron water pipe;
- Installation and construction of 2000 linear feet of 6 inch ductile iron forced main;
- Installation of sanitary sewer lift station and appurtenances;
- Installation of pedestrian safety improvements which include two radar feedback speed indicators and timed flashing school zone sign;

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria:

1. Qualifications of Proposed Project Manager
2. Qualifications / Expertise of Firm
3. Ability to meet schedule

4. Approach to project
5. Familiarity with WSDOT/FHWA standards

7. Past Performance/References
