Sealed bids will be received by the City of Leavenworth, Washington, at the reception desk located at 700 U.S. Highway 2, Leavenworth Washington, until **2:00 p.m., March 25, 2016**. Bids will then be opened and publicly read at **2:05 p.m.** on that same day at City Hall, 700 U.S. Highway 2, Leavenworth, Washington 98826, for:

**Chumstick Highway Multipurpose Trail  
&  
Water/Sewer Extension**

Note: The Proposed Subcontractors list must be submitted with the bid package within the deadline listed above, and will NOT be accepted after that deadline.

The Work to be performed within 60 working days from the date of Notice to Proceed consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and other work or items incidental thereto for:

Chumstick Highway Multipurpose Trail – Construction of 2,100 feet of pedestrian and bicycle trail adjacent to the Chumstick Highway. Trail surface will be ten feet wide with two foot shoulders and BST surfacing. Work will include tree clearing, earth excavation, rock excavation, 48 inch culvert pipe arch, aggregate base and surfacing, and removal and replacement of concrete barriers. Pedestrian safety improvements consisting of two radar feedback speed indicators and a timed flashing school zone sign will also be installed. The trail improvements are funded by the Federal Surface Transportation Program and a WSDOT Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant.

Chumstick Water and Sewer Extension – Construction of 670 lineal feet of 12 inch ductile iron water main, 2,000 lineal feet of 6 inch ductile iron sewer force main, sanitary sewer lift station structures, and appurtenances. Water main and sewer force main to be installed within the Chumstick Highway Multipurpose Trail alignment. The water and sewer extension are funded by the City of Leavenworth and a utility local improvement district.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid proposal, including sales tax. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory payment and performance bonds within the time stated in the Contract Documents, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Leavenworth.

The work on this project shall be accomplished in accordance with the *Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction*, 2016 edition, as issued by the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and the American Public Works Association (APWA), Washington State Chapter (hereafter "Standard Specifications"). The Standard Specifications, as modified or supplemented by the Amendments to the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, all of which are made a part of the Contract Documents, shall govern all of the Work.

The City of Leavenworth in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 CFR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in

response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex in consideration for an award.

To be eligible for award of this contract, the bidder must fill out and submit, as part of its bid proposal, the Local Agency Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Utilization Certification (272-056A) and the Local Agency Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Written Confirmation Document (422-031A) relating to Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (COA) Requirements. A DBE subcontracting goal of **8%** has been established for this project. The DBE Utilization Certification, instructions and Written Confirmation are included in the proposal.

This Invitation to Bid may be canceled at the discretion of the City. If the invitation is canceled, notice of cancellation will be sent to all parties who have registered on the Plan holders list at Builders Exchange. The notice will briefly state the reason for cancellation.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in the bidding, and to make the award to the lowest responsible bidder as determined by the City.
