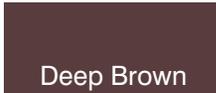


APPROVED OLD WORLD BAVARIAN COLORS

This list is intended to provide guidance to sign makers, designers, business owners, and staff in the development and review of signage which is compliant with Leavenworth Municipal Code 14.10, Signs. It is not intended to limit the use of colors, other than as specified herein, but to typify the pigments available, and use of colors, consistent with the Old World Bavarian Alpine Theme. Metallic colors are to be used minimally as accent such as “leafing.”

Off-whites (pastel whites), and natural or clear stained wood can also be used as accents or primary colors on sign-age.

Bright, Neon, and Fluorescent colors, including stark or bright white, shall NOT be used.
