## SUPPLEMENTAL COUNCIL AGENDA

### 1. Pine Street Bid Award

The City Council is being asked to review and consider the bid awards for the Reconstruction of Pine Street: Phase I. This project is the reconstruction of Pine Street from Titus Road to Ski Hill Drive. The qualified low bid was submitted by Strider Construction for a bid amount of One Million, Eight Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Two dollars and Twenty-Five cents (\$1,862,522.25). The project is funded with a Chelan Douglas Transportation Council Surface Transportation Program Grant (CDTC-STP), a Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) Grant, A TIB Complete Streets Grant, deferred road improvement funds from the Cascade School District, and funds from the City's Transportation Benefit District (TBD).

The project will have two 11 foot travel lanes, on-street parking from Orchard Street to Titus Road on the south side of Pine Street, a five-foot sidewalk on the south side of Pine Street, the completion of the 10-foot Multi-use pathway on the north side of Pine Street, stormwater treatment and conveyance system, upgraded school crossing flashing beacons at the Summit Avenue and Price Avenue intersections, and the replacement of 740 feet of water main. The design meets with the City's Complete Streets Program. The engineering design work was completed by TD&H Engineering, Dan Wolf, P.E.; construction engineering oversight will be completed by TD&H Engineering; and onsite project oversight and documentation will be completed by Pacific Engineering.

The bid documents and references have been reviewed by TD&H Engineering. At the time of this writing we are awaiting the letter of bid award by TD&H and letter of concurrence by TIB, which will be provided Monday morning. The City received concurrence of the bid award by the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) on May 16, 2019.
