Location: 1215 & 1217 Front Street

Applicant: Christopher Hall / Front Street Lodges

Description: One projecting and one wall sign for “Hans & Franz Lodges.” The projecting sign will be 5 square feet with Black Chancery and Clairvaux lettering styles. The sign will hang from the balcony support beam with 3/16” metal chain, painted black. The sign will be constructed of 1.5” cedar with torch burnt texture, v-carved letters and hand painted white lettering and trim with medium blue (PMS 7690) and white mountain embellishment. The wall sign will be 6.4 square feet and mimic the projecting sign in appearance and material.

b. Sign Permit # 2020-056

Location: 220 9th St, Suite E

Applicant: Carole Zacher

Contractor: Gibbs Graphics

Description: New double-sided projecting sign for “Art to Suit You.” The sign will be 5 square feet with Clairvaux lettering style. The sign will utilize black and medium red (PMS 7621) color for lettering medium red trim and embellishments and white background. The sign will be constructed of .75” MDO plywood, hand painted with exterior sign paint. A photo of a comb will be printed vinyl. All metal will be painted black.
