NOTICE - NON-ESSENTIAL CONSTRUCTION ON HOLD & BUILDING PERMITS

In response to the Governor's Memorandum, March 25, 2020, on construction activities which are permitted during the Stay Home Stay Healthy mandate, the City will not be performing any inspections on current construction projects. At this time, the only essential construction is for the City Wastewater Treatment Plant. This will continue until the Stay Home Stay Healthy mandate is lifted.

Residents and businesses needing to make emergency repairs should complete those repairs and email the City Building Official for after the fact permits. Repairs that require inspection prior to operation should request an inspection by emailing or calling the Building Official. If there are questions, you are encouraged to call the Building Official on his cell phone listed below.

Regarding the issuance or submittal of building permits, these activities are also on hold, excluding non-essential construction, until the Stay Home Stay Healthy mandate is lifted. Questions may be directed to the Development Services Manager or City Planner.

We will be processing any required permits after the Stay Home Stay Healthy mandate is lifted. It should be noted that the Governor's address today, March 26, 2020, indicated that the Stay Home Stay Healthy mandate may be extended.
