The City of Leavenworth's Annual Spring Clean Up for single family residential households will take place this year from April 1st through April 30th. *Due to the Coronavirus pandemic, the City will do its best to provide the residents with this service. Please keep in mind that Public Works crews are operating with a reduced staff and will be using all available resources.* The city crew will pick up yard debris at no extra charge. Please limit the bags to 4 per week; additional bags will be charged at \$3.90 per bag.

Leaves, pine needles, and other yard debris must be in the required recyclable paper bags. Plastic bags will not be picked up. The required recyclable paper bags are currently available at several local businesses as well as larger home stores in Wenatchee. The City moved to using the recyclable paper bags in an effort to keep the plastic bags out of the landfill; the recyclable paper bags are compostable along with its contents.

Limbs must be cut into 4 foot or shorter lengths and tied with biodegradable twine into bundles. If there are large limbs, residents are encouraged to cut them up and give them to someone for firewood. No furniture, appliances, dirt, rocks, sod, or building debris will be picked up.
