City of Leavenworth Downtown Paid & Timed Parking Update

September 23, 2020

The City of Leavenworth continues installation of parking meters. Beginning this weekend, the City of Leavenworth will install meters along the Downtown core. This weekend, construction crews will be working on the east side of the City.

Councilwoman Hessburg, Parking Committee Chair indicated that the wait for this new phase of parking management has been long. She has advocated for equitable and manageable parking. She said "Let's work together to get the right parker in the right stall."

City Administrator Ana Cortez indicated that after completing sensor installation in Parking Lots P3, P4, P2, and P5 on Friday September 25th, the construction team would install meters on Front Street, Division, Commercial, and 10th Street. This work will be completed over the weekend.

She indicated that City staff would be reaching out to impacted areas as early as tomorrow to announce over the weekend activities. She stated "streets where work will be done will be designated as no parking areas. We apologize for the inconvenience."

Beginning Saturday, construction crews will be working the following areas:

- Front Street from 13th to 12th
- 12th Street from the Highway to Front
- Front Street from 12th to Division
- Division from Front to Commercial
- Commercial from Division to 10th
- 10th from Commercial to Front
- Commercial from 10th to 9th
