1. Downtown Closure Straw Poll Survey

a. Committee reviewed highlights from the survey results and Troy encouraged each of the committee members to read through all of the details and feedback on their own time.

b. Next steps with information

i. Proceeding with information: Troy suggests that the committee move toward a recommendation for city council. Members of the committee also suggested hosting a table for feedback at the local farmers market to gather more data.

ii. Expansion of project footprint: The committee discussed the importance of mapping out other projects, like parking and a possible underpass, to be included in the big picture design for the closure to better understand how each piece would function together.

iii. Determine scope of work and service and create RFP: Christie and Troy plan to work together on gathering more info as well as creating visuals of the closure in order to move toward building a case for a RFP.

a. Current Project Status: No new updates were discussed.

2. Street Closure Considerations / Pilot

a. Data collection: Joel noted that he has heard only positive feedback about the closure, although lots of people are still asking how long the closure is going to last. The city let the committee know that they will put more messages out on social media and get the word out about the current duration of the closure.
