## Meeting Notes:

- Meeting notes from May 6, 2021 were approved by the Committee with no changes.
- Discussion of Residential Parking Code Updates
  - Our LMC doesn't specify parking in front of mailboxes (or not)
  - State and Federal law should have parking distances for mailboxes.
  - Bring this information to PAC in Aug with all code revisions
- Update on Glacier Lot
  - No new info on groundwork needed
  - Pacific Security is increasing presence to mitigate overnight campers
- Update on ADA Spaces in Parking Lots
  - Striping happening as we get paint and as weather cooperates
  - Evaluating all lots for appropriate ADA locations
  - Some ADA spots will need to be brought up to code if lots are resurfaced/upgraded.
  - Will there be ADA spots for permit parking? Ideally, yes, but as the pilot program rolls out, we can adjust as needed.
- Door Hanger for Residential Zone Example
  - No updates at this time
- Mary Pat Barton brought concerns to the committee:
  - Residents using right of way historically, and concerned this will change when/if a Residential parking zone is implemented.
- Other
  - Parking meters on Front St. – if closed until MLK 2022, remove?
  - Should we increase lot pricing before parking goes live?
  - No answers to these questions at this time
  - Residential Parking Permits – need to build an FAQ for residents
