Residential Advisory Committee (RAC)

Meeting Notes from May 4, 2021

1. Osborn Community Engagement - Bob Stowe

- The committee reviewed and gave feedback on the three initial concept drawings that Bob Stowe presented.
- We will be showcasing posterboards with the concepts printed on them.
 - 3 days in mid-June. Currently slated for a Th/F/S.
 - During the showcase events, we'll collect info from people via a survey/poll.
 - Fill out on a smart phone or have tablets/paper on the tables to fill out the survey/poll at that moment.
- Parking could be an important part of the concepts, depending on what the community wants on the site. BUT, there are creative approaches to parking and we are still in the visioning process.
- Discussion about what elements should be included in the concepts, and based on community input, we will not remove elements that aren't liked by everyone, as we are not yet focusing on details, just overall concepts.

2. CIP – Maxine Whattam

- CIP is a planning document – a fiscal tool to help us manage capital improvement projects.
- It's reviewed annually, and updated during the City's biannual budget process.
- Funding comes from many sources. If we have funding, we will do a project. Some projects just need to be done and we will go find funding.

3. Residential Parking Fees – Ana Cortez

- Residential Permit Fees are currently proposed as:
 - \$0 for resident permits
 - Each *resident* can apply for 1 permit
 - \$65 additional resident permits
 - \$0 for guest permits
- Residential Permit cost could change in the future. We have left it open in the code for the future and the fee schedule can be revisited at a later date.
- Zones were created via a sub-committee of the Parking Advisory Committee. The goal was to create zones that were fairly distributed based on:
 - current parking behavior during festivals/summer weekends
 - the size of each zone
 - number of housing units in each zone
