### General

- Mike Smith is now our fire prevention specialist. Mike and I will be on a Monday-Thursday until February then we will transition to five day a week coverage.
- We have signed an agreement with Cascade Medical Center to provide personnel to staff a third out Basic Life Support ambulance.

- 

### Training

- The Highschool Cadets will be finishing up their structure fire training this month and transitioning to wildland training.
- The Dept of Natural Resources and the US Forest Service have assisted the Cadets with applying for seasonal firefighter jobs with their agencies.

### Response

- We had a rash of broken sprinkler pipes after the "Deep Freeze" on Dec 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> when temps subsided. All businesses have made repairs and systems are back in service.
- Most of the Village of Lights weekends went smoothly despite challenges with traffic due to weather conditions.
- On Friday Dec 16<sup>th</sup>, we had an interagency response for an active shooter threat. Law enforcement took the lead on securing the scene and suspect. The Fire Dept alerted the surrounding Fire and Ems agencies putting them on standby in the event the situation escalated into a Mass Casualty Response.

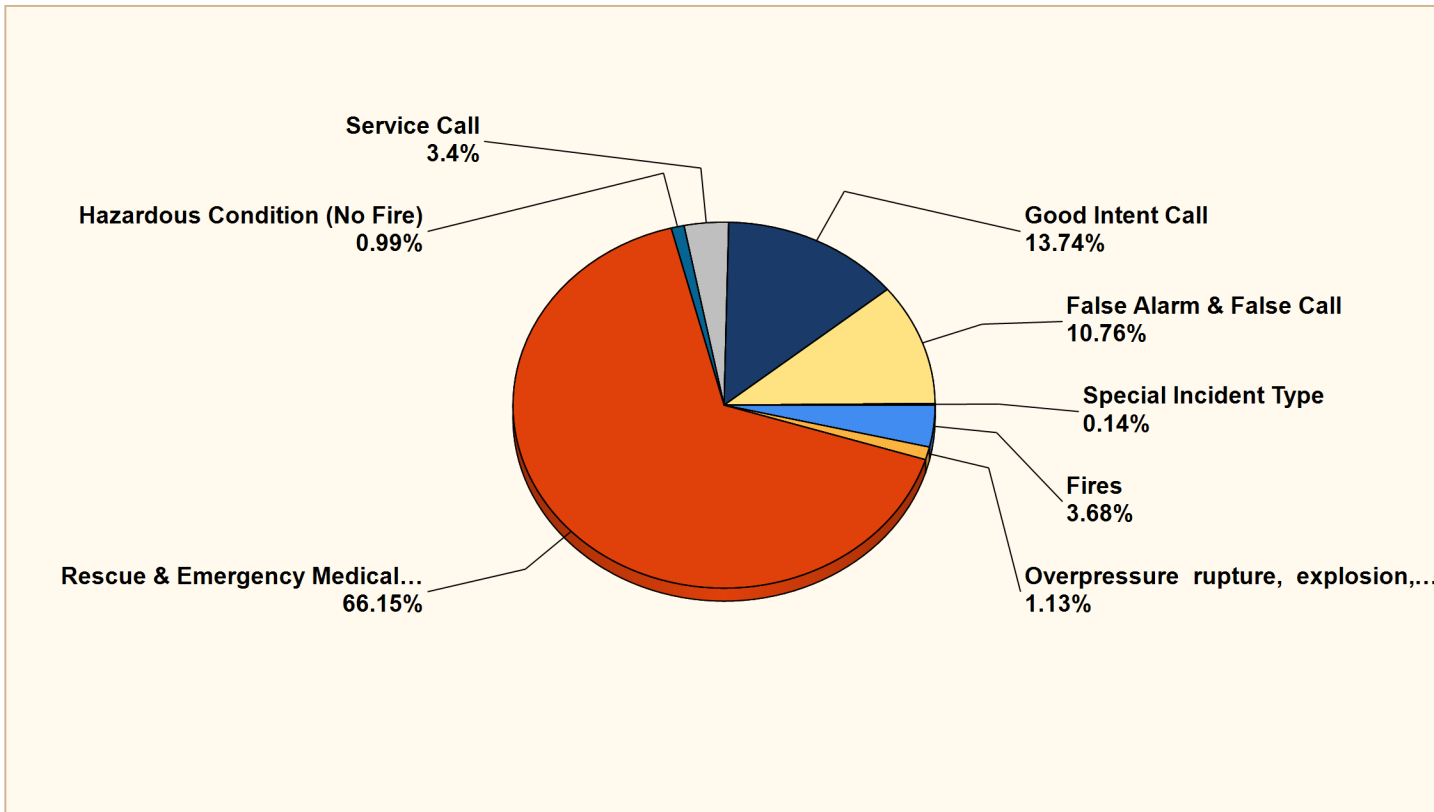
